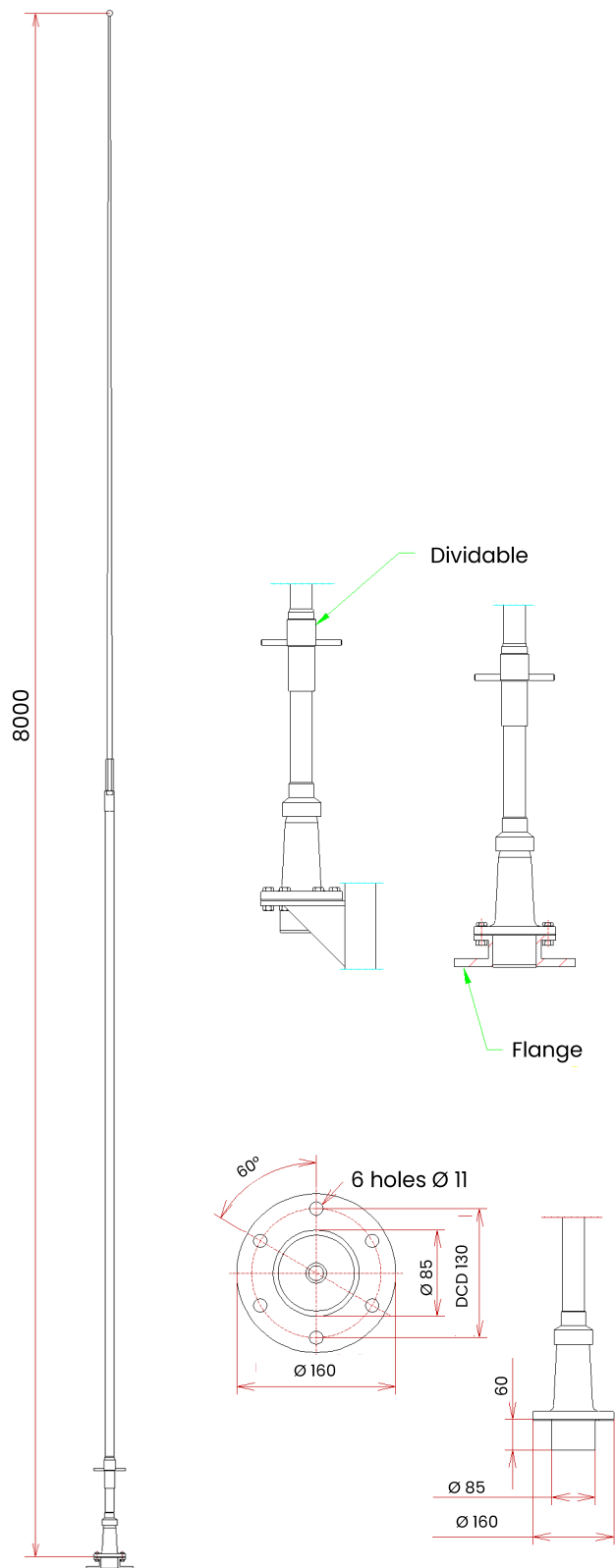


AT82D/D

HF two-piece sectional whip, monopole, 8 m, 1.6–30 MHz

Tactical Antennas: Tactical and Base Station



Application

AT82D/D is a high quality fibreglass transmitting antenna mainly for maritime use in the MF and HF bands. The antenna is equivalent to the AT82D except that it is dividable above the base. The main part of the antenna can then be removed without the use of tools. When the whip is removed a long wire antenna can be connected at the remaining part of the base.

Mounting

The AT82D/D is well suited for mounting on top of the radio cabin. If the feeding insulator is not long enough, extensions are available.

The flange holes are matched to M10 bolts.

Frequency in MHz, antenna mounted on a 2m steel pipe over flat steel roof. Feed line 2m.
